

Bolded and italicised: the President, Treasurer and Secretary of the club in line with the new (2018) structure NB. Nominally OUYC has two secretaries and two treasurers to handle the specifics of yachting and dinghy finance and administration. However, each year, one secretary on one side of the club and one treasurer on the other side of the club will be the senior, and the point of contact for Sportsfed. To keep the club balanced, this will swap annually.
For example, in 2019 the "Dinghy Treasurer" will be the OUYC "Treasurer" and the "Yachting Rear Commodore" will be the OUYC
"Secretary". In 2020 it will be the "Yachting Treasurer" and the "Dinghy Rear Commodore".

Social Sailing Secretary - Organises social sailing in the summer
Events Secretary - Organises dinghy events held by OUYC including cuppers
Bosun - Maintains the flights of boats at Farmoor
Social Secretaries - Organise social events on respective sides of the club. Work together to organise the Annual Dinner
Cruising Secretary - Organises yachting cruising events
Training Secretary - Organises yachting training
Membership Secretary - Responsible for maintaining the membership database and liasing with the Life Membership Secretary
